



HOW TO REPORT SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASES IN GWINNETT, NEWTON AND ROCKDALE COUNTIES

1. Report electronically via SENDSS!

Patient information is entered into a secure online database managed by the Georgia Department of Public Health. Cases are immediately transmitted electronically to a Communicable Disease Specialist for follow-up.
