

Addition Checklist – Land Use

For the addition to or modification of structures, a review is required. Additions or modifications will need to be submitted for review if: 1) they require an increase or alteration to this existing on-site sewage management system (OSSMS); or, 2) will require a site evaluation of the lot of OSSMS for compliance. The following is a checklist of items required for submission for review:

- 1. A completed addition application and a paid fee of \$110.00 if addition does not impact septic system. If increasing number of bedrooms or addition impacts septic system a paid fee of \$250.00.
- 2. Copy of the floor plan with all rooms labeled <u>does not have to be drawn to scale</u>
- 3. A drawing that includes the following information:
 - a) Property lines and dimensions of the property <u>drawn to scale</u>
 - b) Footprint (shape) of the house, and its location on the property drawn to scale
 - c) Location and footprint (shape) of all existing structures (e.g., driveway, sidewalk, pool, patio, deck, shed) <u>drawn to scale</u>
 - d) Location and footprint (shape) of the addition you are applying for to include the dimensions of the addition and the distance from the property lines <u>drawn to scale</u>

NOTE: a soil report cannot be used as the drawing – a separate drawing shall be submitted **NOTE:** items listed in (a-d), <u>**MUST**</u> be drawn to scale using one of the following:

- 1["] = 40[']
- 1" = 30'
- 1" = 20'
- 4. For lots less than 1.5 acres, a Level 3 soil report will be required for swimming pools or additions of 500sqft or more.
- 5. If increasing number of bedrooms, a Level 3 soil report will be required. Number of bedrooms based on current septic inspection report.
 - Please note that an original stamped Level 3 Soil Report from an approved soil classifier recognized by the State of Georgia Environmental Health Office may be required for any addition. If a soil report is required, the review will not be able to continue until that information is submitted. For your information;

If the existing septic system needs to be modified or relocated, you must obtain a permit. An additional fee will be required for the permit.
