

GNR COVID-19 Specimen Point of Collection Sites (SPOCs)

On March 17, 2020, GNR stood up our first specimen collection site (SPOC) in Gwinnett County. Currently, SPOCs operate daily in Gwinnett and on the line between Newton and Rockdale Counties. In addition, large scale collection events (>800) are being operated several times each month. SPOCs continue to offer specimen collection services at no cost to patients meeting GA testing criteria.
