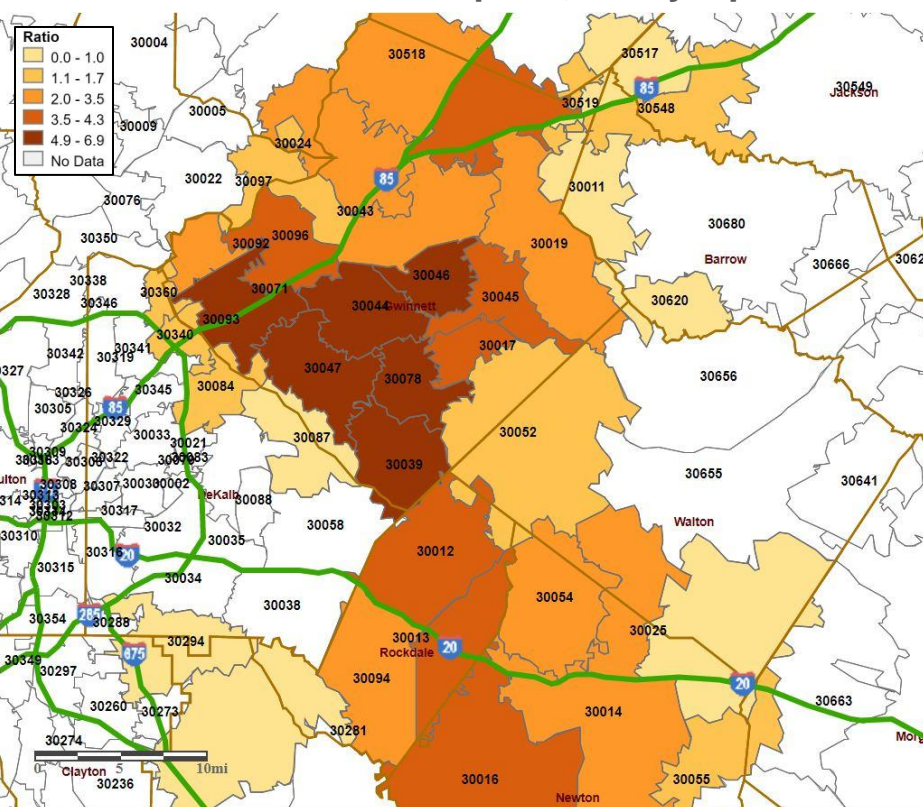

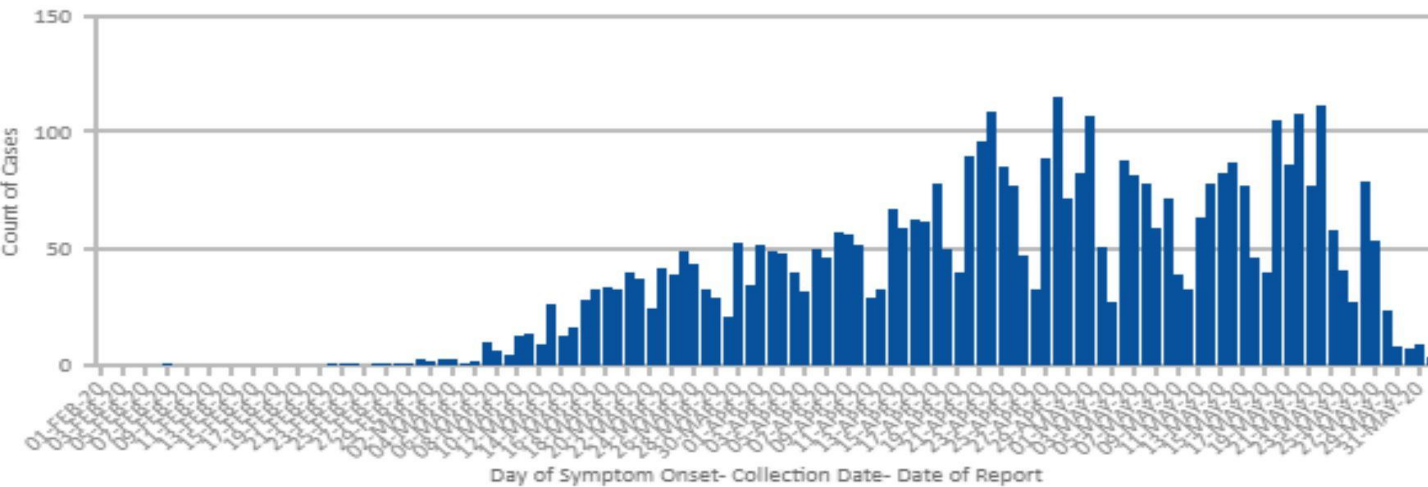
GNR COVID-19 Specimen Point of Collection Sites (SPOCs)

On March 17, 2020, GNR stood up our first specimen collection site (SPOC) in Gwinnett County. Currently, SPOCs operate daily in Gwinnett County and on the line between Newton and Rockdale Counties. SPOCs continue to offer specimen collection services at no cost to patients meeting GA testing criteria. Specimen collection at SPOC sites is done by appointment only. Appointments can be made by calling 770-513-5631.

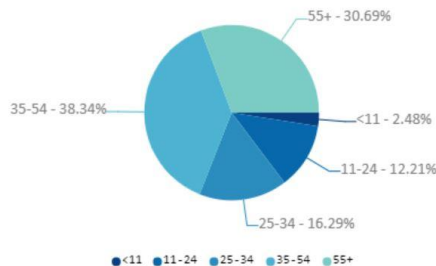

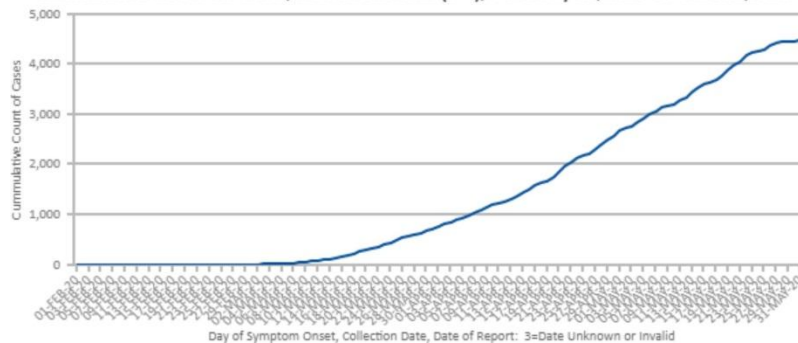
Daily Confirmed and Presumptive COVID-19 Infections, LAWRENCEVILLE (3-4), February 01,2020 to June 01,2020



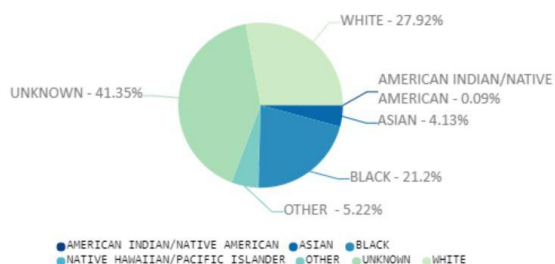
Confirmed and Presumptive COVID-19 Infections by Age Group, LAWRENCEVILLE (3-4), February 01,2020 to May 30,2020
