Job Summary: The Clinical Infectious Disease Director will work as an integral member of the Epidemiology and Infectious Disease program. The individual will provide clinical and direct programmatic oversight for District Infectious Disease programs including HIV Prevention, STD Prevention, and Tuberculosis Control. Position will also provide training, clinical review, and audits for District STD/HIV/TB clinical functionality. Candidate will be integrally involved with the new HIV Ending the Epidemic program expansion. The candidate will also provide clinical care and clinical training in all program area. Position will also support the Notifiable Disease Epidemiology team, including supporting internal and external infection control assessments and enforcement of necessary disease control measures.

Minimum Qualifications: Master's degree in nursing, nursing administration, public health or directly related field from an accredited college or university AND Two years in an administrative or supervisory capacity AND current Georgia license as a Registered Professional Nurse OR Bachelor's degree in nursing from an accredited college or university AND Five years of experience as a Registered Nurse, Two years of which in an administrative or supervisory capacity AND current Georgia license as a Registered Professional Nurse OR Eight years of experience as a Registered Nurse, Two years of which in an environment related to the area of assignment, Four years of which as a supervisor AND current Georgia license as a Registered Professional Nurse.
