Job Summary

Candidates will function as a part of a multidisciplinary team of Public Health professionals providing excellent customer service and clinical care in District Public Health clinics and community based events. Candidate will provide clinics services at mobile clinical events at a variety of locations including schools, health fairs, businesses, community events, faith based locations, etc. Provision of clinical services will include: basis health assessments including vitals, blood pressure, blood glucose, etc.; administering immunizations in accordance with the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP); providing referrals for clinical care; assessing and caring for patients under nurse protocol; supporting community and patient clinical needs related to emergencies and emerging Public Health issues; and preforming other duties as assigned to meet organizational clinical needs. The mobile team RN will need to have flexibility in hours as many events occur in the evenings or on weekends. When events are not scheduled, the Mobile team nurse will support GNR Public Health clinics. Full-time nurses will be scheduled 40 hours per week and are eligible for benefits. Hourly nurses should be able to commit 25-29 hours per week and are not eligible for full time benefits.

Qualifications

Copy of 3 year Driving Record, Official College Transcript, GA Nursing License & CPR Certification must be submitted with application.

Minimum

Associate's degree in nursing from an accredited college or university AND completion of a PHN course within one year of hire AND current Georgia Registered Professional Nurse license AND CPR certification. Note: No experience required.
